# Clinica San José

In the western highlands of Guatemala, Central America, Presentation Sisters Elizabeth Remily and JoAnna Bruno have completed building a healthcare clinic. This much-needed clinic provides affordable primary health care to the 68,000 Mayan-Mam speaking people who inhabit the 77 villages dotted across the mountainous region. Second to that purpose is to educate native staff in various skills of the clinic and eventually entrust the administration and direction of the clinic to professional religious sisters from Guatemala.

Young adults are also able to gain valuable vocation knowledge through computer classes Sister Deb is teaching through a program offered by Mater Dei Catholic parish. Offering these vital skills allows students in Kalomo greater opportunities for employment and a means to provide for their future.

The dream in the near future is to build an education center for the computer and mentoring programs.

Sister Virginia McCall began serving the people of Kaoma, Zambia, Africa, in 2007. She, along with three other Presentation Sisters, work with the people in the area and assist them in creating a better life for themselves and their families.

Sister Virginia developed and continues to build the Kaoma Sustainability Project, which includes conservation farming, sewing school uniforms, raising fish, providing small business loans for women and various educational endeavors. The goal of these projects is to assist people in generating income to become self-sustaining.

## **COOPERATIVE FARMING EFFORTS**

*The Chilombo village has had many problems in the past. They now have turned this around and have taken the initiative to choose new leaders. They requested the Board give them another chance. Board members told the group they would need to show evidence of their commitment to work together as a group by planting a vegetable garden. They worked in earnest and produced a beautiful assortment of vegetables which they planned to sell at the market to generate income for the group. However, just as the vegetables were ready to harvest, a severe rain storm destroyed everything. They wanted to try again so the group was given seed and fertilizer for one hector of maize. They have worked well together. They planted late and avoided the drought that damaged crops others had planted earlier. They are now the group with the best field of maize.*

## WALK A MILE IN MY SHOES

by a "guest" at the Rebuild center - age 23

*"Homeless people are so lazy." "Why don't they get a job?" "They're alcoholics and drug addicts." "They steal." These are things people, myself included, have said about homeless people. I became homeless and I quickly realized that perception is not always reality.*

*There are lots of factors that affect homeless people: mentally you are in a state of shock - a bump in the road that you cannot so easily roll over; physically you are on constant alert for your own well-being and where to put your medications and the few possessions you may have; emotionally you are on a roller-coaster filled with ups and downs and lots of sudden turns.*

*It is my hope that in the future we will look at one another through eyes of love and the understanding that each and every one of us has our faults. We are each a work in progress, working toward a goal . . . to enjoy life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.*

# Vocations Ministry

For the past 125 years, the Presentation Sisters have committed themselves to the education of youth. For the past 16 years, the Sisters have focused that commitment to our youth by sponsoring leadership camps for junior high girls and retreats and service experiences for high school women. These experiences provide a safe place for young women to talk about faith and become more comfortable as Christian leaders. Young women continue to tell us how grateful they are for this positive, faith-filled environment that allows them to develop their own spiritual and emotional maturity.

# *Caminando Juntos*

Caminando Juntos, sponsored by the Presentation Sisters, is a ministry with the Latino population in the Sioux Falls area. Some of the services they provide these newly arrived immigrants are:

- Classes in adult English, citizenship preparation, support groups for women
- Immigration counseling and legal services
- Assistance with accessing healthcare and other social services
- Visitation to hospitals, homes and state penitentiary
- Accompaniment of women and children suffering domestic abuse

This ministry needs financial support for the many educational and immigration materials we use in the above programs. There is also a great need for direct financial aid for our Good Neighbor Fund, which services those Latinos who find themselves in desperate financial circumstances.

# Aberdeen Area Hispanic Ministry

Sister Myra Remily provides accompaniment to Hispanics in the Aberdeen area who need help understanding the social service system and transitioning into our American culture. This ministry provides advocacy for the issues that face this growing population and accompanies people to the WIC office, dentist, chiropractor, and doctor to translate for them. She has also worked with some medical staff on translating their forms into Spanish, helped mothers obtain passports for their children and accompanied families to school conferences, offering translation services.

Sister Myra teaches English as a Second Language (ESL) classes and beginning and advanced Spanish classes to people in the community who wish to learn this language.

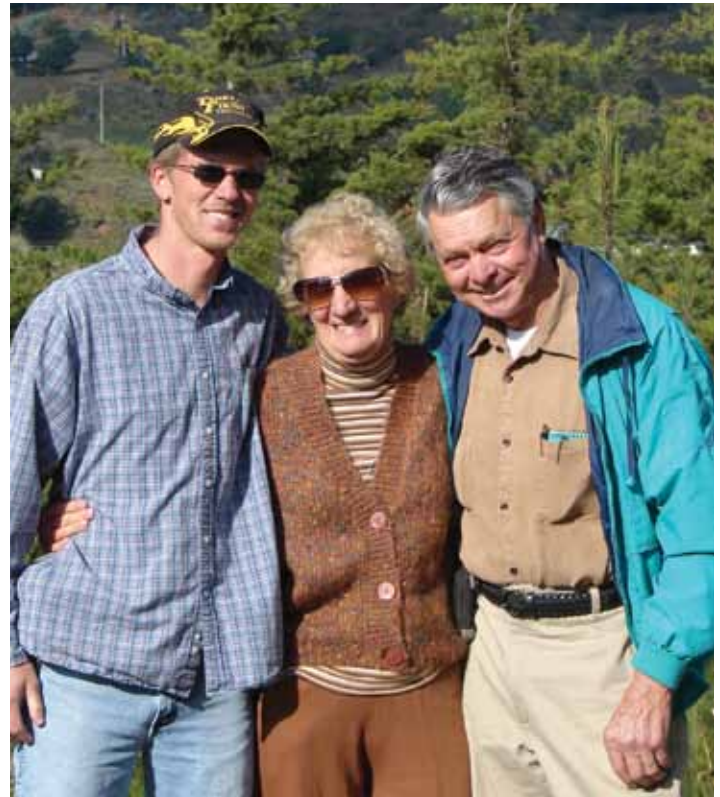

## There is Still Time

Great News for retired individuals! The IRS has extended the IRA "qualified charitable distribution" rules through 2011. This means that individuals over the age of 70 ½ are able to make charitable distributions [combined up to \$100,000] from a traditional IRA directly to charity (1) without having to count the distribution as taxable income and (2) can replace the "required minimum distribution" requirement up to the contribution made. This provision is set to expire December 31, 2011. This IRA charitable tool is relatively easy. Please feel free to call Sister Janice or consult your tax advisor.
