

## **Storm Mountain Center Information**

Storm Mountain is a camp owned and operated by the Dakota United Methodist Church. It is located on 264 acres of beautiful Black Hills wilderness, and is completely surrounded by National Forest. There is plenty of space to include a variety of indoor and outdoor activities.

### **Storm Mountain has policies that we follow while we are at the camp, including**

- No cliff climbing
- Hiking must be done with two companions; trail maps are available. Hikers must sign out and sign in.
- Quiet time outdoors and in the cabins is from 10:00pm until 7:30am.
- Absolutely no food or beverages in the cabins or third floor of the lodge.
- No pets are allowed.
- Cell phones, iPods, iPads, MP3 players, and other electronic devices are not allowed at camp. Please keep them at home. If they are brought to camp, expect that they will be collected and turned into camp staff for the week and returned Friday.
- No alcohol, drugs, fireworks, illegal substances or firearms allowed
