Reflection: As we reflect upon the teachings of Christ, let us look inside ourselves and set aside time for reflection, repentance and renewal in our lives.


How will you take time for yourself this Lenten season?

1st Week of Lent

Reflection: Jesus knows us intimately, not even sin can cloud his vision of us. He continues to forgive us and welcomes us with love and compassion.


May I open my heart to Jesus' loving gaze so I can pass onto others what I have received, treating all with respect and dignity.


Reflection: In and through Jesus Christ we discover what it means to be in right relationship with God, our sisters and brothers, and all of creation.
