INSPIRING HOPE AND A FUTURE FOR "DREAMERS"



For the past six years, our office has assisted more than 60 young people, also known as “Dreamers”, obtain DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals). They came to the U.S. as children, and have hopes and dreams of building a home and a future in the U.S. These young people contribute to our community as barbers, teachers, bankers, supervisors, and more. They bravely share their stories with South Dakota lawmakers and leaders to advocate for the continuation of the DACA program.

Through the gracious contributions of our ESL teachers and classroom volunteers, as well as the Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish, hundreds of adult learners have the opportunity to learn English and advance in their daily lives each year. Dozens of young people from Augustana University and the broader community inspire hope in our students by building their confidence and language skills and by forming lasting connections.
