## February 28, 2021 ~ Second Sunday of Lent **The Beloved Son**

Then God said [to Abraham]

"Take **your son** Isaac, your only one, **whom you love**, and go to the land of Moriah.

There you shall offer him up as a holocaust on a height that I will point out to you." Genesis 22:1b-2a

Again the LORD's messenger called to Abraham from heaven and said: "I swear by myself, declares the LORD, that because you acted as you did in not withholding from me **your beloved son**, I will bless you abundantly and make your descendants as countless as the stars of the sky and the sands of the seashore; Genesis 22:16,17a
