Catholic High School \$2,000 Scholarship

- * Family values Catholic education and demonstrates Christian values
- * **Family has financial need**
- * Student achieves a B average or better
- * Student participates in extracurricular activities, has community involvement and shows leadership qualities
- * Family is registered with a Catholic Parish in the Sioux Falls Diocese

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please complete the application on reverse side. As a part of the application process, we require an essay to be written by the applicant if they are in grades 6-12 or a parent/guardian for applicant in K-5. **Scholarship submissions are limited to one child in grades K-5.** The topic for the short essay is "The importance & value of a Catholic education and how the scholarship would financially impact my family."
